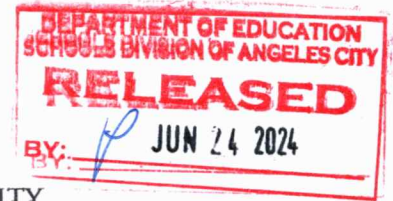

Strengthening Research in the Division of Angeles City: Looking thru the Lens of Planning and Management

In line with the MATATAG Agenda, the Schools Division of Angeles City continue to support its teachers by providing the right environment in the conduct of Basic Research, Action Research and Innovation which help them to teach better and deliver quality education to the learners.

In line with this, an analysis is made looking thru the lens of management and planning rather in the skills and knowledge of teachers in making research. This is premised on the assumption that “if it is not in the school plan and no budget allotted, it means there is intent to conduct it.

Data from the Basic Education Information System showed that only 20 out of 68 schools or 29% only conducted research for 2023.

For Senior High School: Gov. Rafael Lazatin IS – ES, Rafael Lazatin SH, Angeles City National Trade, AMSIC SHS

Validating this information from inventory of research proposals showed that only 10 were submitted from January to June 2023. The result can be attributed as well to the budget put into research. The 2023 allotted budget for research is at miniscule 0.2% against the total School Operating Budget. The total research spending for 2023 is at P 111,550 and was spent for meals probably during the Learning Action Cells or In School Trainings.

In **2024**, the budget for research is at P 1,537,648 or 1.6% of the total SOB. The average budget allocation for research at Division Level is at 2% against total SOB. Cuayan ES and GRLIS at 5% while Air Force City ES, Apung Guidang ES, Leoncia Village ES, Angeles City National Trade School at 4%. The data showed that all schools allotted budget for research except DAMIS, Pulungbulu ES, Belen Homesite ES, Angeles City Senior High School, DAMIS JHS, Sto. Domingo IS JHS.

Analysis on the spending of research budget reveals the following:

a) For the Elementary Schools:

Out of the 43 schools, there are 13 schools with zero spending as of October 6, 2024. The 30 schools with spending spent their budget on meals probably during their INSET. Out of these 30 schools, 21 do not have research proposal.

Policy Recommendations

The data from 2023 and 2024 show that research output can be influenced. Putting research budget in the SOB shows that there is an intent and conscious effort of producing research and innovation.

The focus placed by the school heads by including of research budget in the SOB manifest their desire to support their teachers in producing studies that can improve teaching and learning.

The following are recommended:

- a) Continue allotting research budget in SOB. Judicious usage of budget.
- b) Relative to succession planning, identify teachers who are potential to handle bigger responsibilities and support them in conducting research/innovation.
- c) Strengthen the role of the School Research Coordinator. SRC should have at least 1 research output of his/her own.
- d) Budget must not be limited to meals but must be used in providing support to teachers like bond papers and other expenses in the conduct of research.
- e) Teachers / Proponents with excellent papers will be rewarded as Outstanding Researchers which can be used as MOV for Outstanding Work


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- c) Strengthen the role of the School Research Coordinator. SRC should have at least 1 research output of his/her own per school year.
