- 2. The participants per learning area are required to take the **pretest and posttest** to be administered before and after the training. They are also requested to bring their laptops, extension wires, pocket WiFi and other possible ICT resources for internet connection.
- 3. The activity aims to:
 - a. demonstrate knowledge and skills on unpacking/ merging/ clustering competencies per grade level and learning area;
 - b. integrate 21st century skills, inclusion principles and brain- based learning theories in teaching and learning processes;
 - c. apply pedagogical approaches and assessment per learning area for effective lesson planning and simulate collaborative learning expertise; and
 - d. exhibit positive/ inclusive attitude towards the implementation of the MATATAG curriculum.
