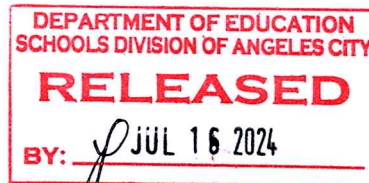

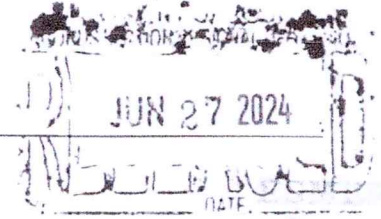

**NATIONAL IMPLEMENTATION OF LEARNER RIGHTS AND PROTECTION (LRP)
ON WHEELS 2024**

1. Pursuant to the DepEd Order No. 3 s. 2021, the Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) serves as the lead office of the Department in formulating policies, planning, implementing, coordinating and monitoring projects, programs and activities concerning all matters pertaining to the rights of the learners in basic education.
2. Guided with the MATATAG framework, **Take** good care of learners by promoting learner well-being, inclusive education, and a positive learning environment. The Learner Rights and Protection Office (LRPO) will launch the **“Learner Rights and Protection on Wheels”** on July 29, 2024 alongside with the opening of classes as part of its mandate and commitment to ensure the protection and upholding of the rights of learners nationwide.
3. The activity aims to bring educational rights awareness and protection services to create a safer and more inclusive learning environment for all learners in line with DepEd’s zero-tolerance policy for any act of learner abuse, exploitation, violence, discrimination, bullying, and other forms of abuse, and emphasizes the importance of LRP in Schools.



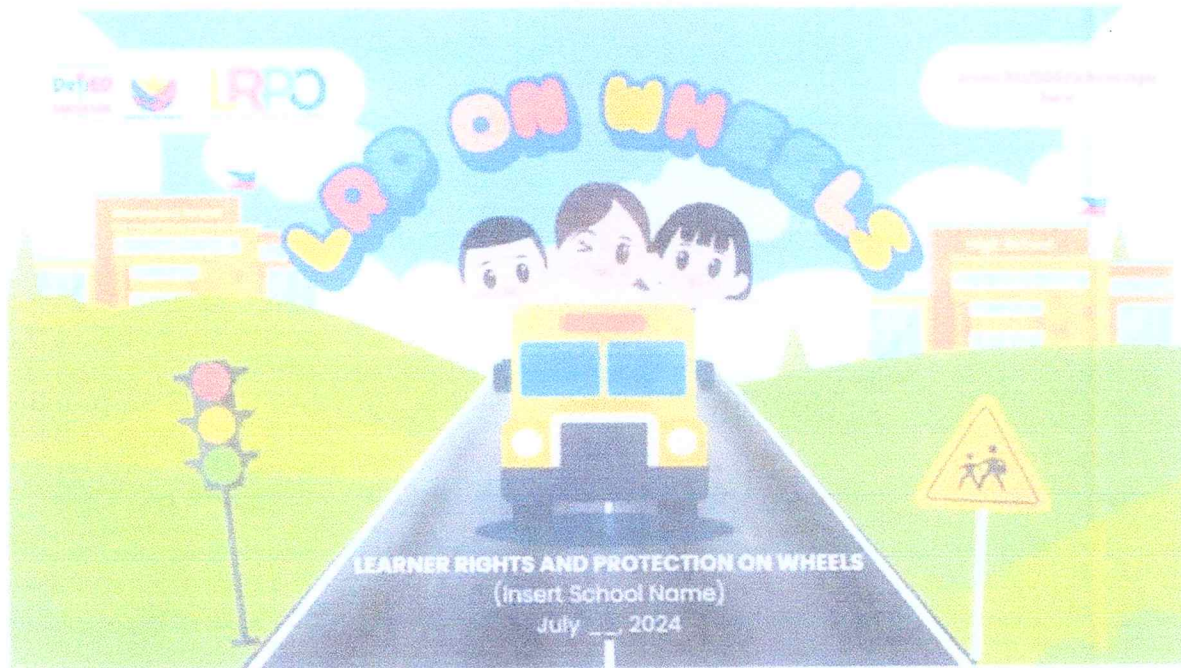
