

The National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP) in collaboration with the Bureau of Learning Delivery-Teaching and Learning Division (BLD-TLD), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and Human Resource Development Division (HRDD), shall conduct Batch 3 of Training on Trainers Methodology (TM) Level 1 for Senior High School Technical-Vocational-Livelihood (SHS-TVL) and Junior High School-Special Program for Technical-Vocational Education (JHS\_SPTVE) from May 20-29, 2024 (face-to-face), July 1 to 13, 2024 (Online) and July 18-27, 2024 (face-to-face) at NEAP-R3, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 2. The training aims to equip SHS-TVL and JHS-SPTVE teachers in the region with the necessary knowledge, attitude, values, and skills in accordance with the prevailing standards in the Technical-Vocational Education and Training (TVET) sector. It covers the competencies required of a Technical-Vocational Trainer to perform based on TESDA's Training Regulations of Trainers Methodology 1 in the following areas:
  - a. Planning training sessions;

- b. Facilitating training sessions (with e-learning);
- c. Supervising work-based learning;
- d. Conducting competency assessment;
- e. Maintaining training facilities; and
- f. Utilizing electronic media in facilitating training.
- 3. Participants are required to bring their laptops, chargers, and extension cords for the duration of the training.
- 4. Expenses relative to this activity such as board and lodging, travel expenses, training registration costs, assessment fees, training supplies and materials, and internet expenses of participants shall be charged against downloaded funds from the Central Office, while traveling expenses of resource persons, training managers, and assistants, and BLD and NEAP representatives will be covered through direct payment, subject to the existing auditing rules and regulations.
- 5. Moreover, teacher participants shall be entitled to Service Credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 53, s. 2003, titled *Updated Guidelines on Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers*. Likewise, non-teaching personnel including Division Chiefs may avail Compensatory Time- Off under CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 titled *Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Service Rendered*, on their direct involvement in the TVL TM 1 training. Schools Division Offices are expected to strongly support the participation of their teacher representatives in the training. Nonetheless, adherence to the **No Disruption of Classes Policy** as stated in DepEd Order No. 9, s. 2005 must be observed.
- 6. The check-in and registration of participants shall be in the afternoon of May 19 and July 17, 2024, with dinner as the first meal, while check-out shall be on May 29 and July 27, 2024, with p.m. snack as the last meal.
