RQUIZBEE: REGIONAL QUIZZING OF UNIQUE IDEAS IN A ZESTFUL COMPETITION USING BRAINPOWER AND ENTHUSIASM

To: Schools Division Superintendents Chiefs, School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) Chiefs, Curriculum Implementation Division (CID) Division Learner Formation Coordinators Public Secondary School Heads All Others Concerned

1. The Philippines ranked 78/78 in 2018 and 77/81 in 2022 in the Programme for International Student Assessment (PISA), with this recent result, the learners in the Philippines remain among the world's weakest in math, reading and science thus, showing no significant improvement from the country's performance in 2018. Specifically, Philippines scored two points better in mathematics, the highlight of PISA 2022, going from 353 in 2018 to 355 in 2022. While, for science, the Philippines' average score dropped by one point from 356 to 355 on the other hand, reading had biggest improvement but just by seven points, scoring 347 from 340 in 2018. With these results, Filipino learners appear to trail behind their global counterparts by an average of five to six years' worth of schooling.

2. As one of the responses to the learning crisis, the Department of Education (DepEd) Region III recognizes the urgent need for transformative change in the country's education system thus, DepEd Region III through Education Support Services Division (ESSD) in collaboration Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) shall conduct the RQuizBEE: Regional Quizzing of Unique Ideas in a Zestful competition using BrainpowEr and Enthusiasm with the theme "Global Minds: Exploring Knowledge through PISA" on December 04, 2024 in St. Scholastica's Academy, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.

3. The activity aims the following.

3.1 **P**romote learning across various subjects, and encourage participants to expand their knowledge base;

3.2 Inspire a passion for continuous learning and curiosity about the world around them.

3.3 **S**ustain collaboration and communication among team members, enhancing group dynamics

3.4 develop **A**nalytical and quick-thinking skills through challenging questions and problem-solving scenarios; and







3.5 Create an ultimate fun learning experience for all involved, promoting camaraderie and a love for knowledge.

4. Relative to this activity, the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) through the Division Learner Formation Coordinators shall form one (1) team to represent their respective division. The SDOs are encouraged to conduct School/District/Division contest to ensure the equal opportunity to all learners. Enclosed is the guidelines and mechanics for reference.

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Guidelines and Mechanics

RQuizBEE: Regional Quizzing of Unique Ideas in a Zestful competition using BrainpowEr and Enthusiasm

"Global Minds: Exploring Knowledge through PISA"

Target participants: Junior High School Learners (Grade 9)

Target Date: December 4, 2024

Venue: St. Scholastica's Academy, City of San Fernando, Pampanga.

Guidelines and Mechanics:

1. The Regional Quiz Bee shall be a team contest, composed of fifteen (15) Grade 9 learners, five learners shall be assigned in each category of the contest.

2. The competition shall cover English, Mathematics and Science learning areas.

3. The competition has three rounds: EASY, AVERAGE and DIFFICULT. Below are the corresponding number of items, points, and time allotted for answering each item.

4. The questions will be given in multiple- choice form in three rounds.

5. Each team shall be provided with whiteboard, markers and eraser. It shall be used for their answer in each question. The final answer shall be written legibly.

6. Each team shall start with a zero score at the start of Easy round. The accumulation of points all throughout the contest will be cumulative.







7. The Quiz Bee Master will read each of the question twice. The question will be also presented via PowerPoint presentation and will be flashed on TV or LED screen.

8. Each team shall have to wait for the signal "GO" from the Quiz Bee Master before answering the question.

9. The Quiz Bee master shall read and verify the team's answer.

9. The team who accumulated highest score shall be declared as 1st Place winner and follows the 2nd, 3rd 4th and 5th.

10. In case there is tie, clincher round takes place only for the tied team. In the Clincher Round, as many questions will be asked. Each question is equivalent to five (5) points. The team who first gets 20 points shall be declared as the 1st place winner.

11. All protests should be referred to the Board of Judges immediately, before the Quiz Bee master reads the next question.

12. The Board of Judges shall be in complete control of the competition; their decision shall be final and irrevocable in all questions/protests.

13. Any violation of the above-mentioned guidelines and mechanics shall result to the disqualification.

Cash Prize

The winner shall receive the following.

1st place winner – Php.30,000.00 and plaque for the school and certificate of recognition for the learners

2nd place winner – Php.25,000.00 and plaque for the school and certificate of recognition for the learners

3rd place winner - Php.20000.00 and plaque for the school and certificate of recognition for the learners

4th place winner - Php.15,000.00 and plaque for the school and certificate of recognition for the learners

5th place winner - Php.10, 000.00 and plaque for the school and certificate of recognition for the learners
