- 1. This is to announce the conduct of the 2024 Division Schools Press Conference, which will be held on December 7,14, and 18, 2024, at Angeles Elementary School, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 2. The conference aims to:
  - provide a venue for an enriching learning experience for students interested in pursuing journalism as a career;
  - enhance journalistic competence through friendly, individual, and group competitions;
  - choose the participants who will represent SDO Angeles to the Regional Schools Press slated on February 25-27, 2024 in Balanga City, Bataan.

  - C. School Publication Contest (Date of submission: January 16, 2024)

- D. Search for the Outstanding School Paper Adviser and Campus Journalist
  Date of submission of documents: January 24, 2025
- 4. A registration fee of two hundred and fifty Pesos (P250.00) to be charged from the school publication fund, MOOE, or other local funds will be collected from each participant (Campus Journalist and School Paper Adviser) to cover expenses for the honoraria and meals of the evaluators/ facilitators/TWG, materials, rentals, maintenance, and other incidental expenses subject to the usual accounting rules and auditing procedure. Pre-registration and payment to the division's cashier will only be until December 4, 2024, at 5:00 p.m. Please, submit the two copies of the list of participants during the pre-registration.

Each public or private elementary and secondary school can send two (2) contestants per category in the Individual Writing Contests but only one team for the group or team contests.

- 5. For Radio Broadcasting, each school shall have two teams composed of seven (7) members for the English and Filipino categories. Likewise, the TV Broadcasting Team must also be composed of seven (7) members, but it is a category intended only for High School contestants. The team members for TV and Radio Broadcasting should not be participants in any Individual Writing Contests.
- 6. Desktop Publishing contestants shall be composed of seven (7) members in English and Filipino for both Elementary and Secondary. However, Online Publishing is the category for Secondary Level only with five (5) members for both English and Filipino.
- 7. In Photojournalism, contestants are allowed to use a DSLR camera with 18-55m, f/35-5-6 standard lens. Cellular phones, extra digital cameras, mirrorless, or any other cameras are not allowed in this contest category.
- 8. The opening program will be on December 7, 2024, at 8:00 a.m., while the awarding ceremony will be on December 18, 2024, at 1:00 p.m. The official venue is Angeles Elementary School, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 9. For the smooth conduct of the 2024 DSPC, a separate online orientation will be conducted for all the concerned participants on the following dates:

November 22, 2024 - School Paper Advisers and Coaches

December 2, 2024 - Members of the Technical Working Group/ Facilitators The official link for the online orientation will be sent through the SPA Group Chat.
