INSTITUTIONALIZATION OF LEARNING AND SERVICE CONTINUITY PLANS (LSCP) IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS IN ANGELES CITY

- Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 22, s. 2024, which institutionalizes the 1. Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LSCP) as a key planning document in ensuring the continuous delivery of basic education services before, during, and after disruptions or emergencies, the Schools Division Office of Angeles City, through the Curriculum Implementation Division and School Governance and Operations Division-Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (SGOD-DRRM) Unit, will conduct a district-level activity titled "Institutionalization of Learning and Service Continuity Plan (LSCP) in All Public Schools in Angeles City". This shall be conducted on August 13-15, 2025, in conjunction with the Climate Risk Mapping, Hazard Assessment, and Rapid Damage Assessment and Needs Analysis (RDANA) Workshop for Safer Learning Spaces.
- 2. The objectives of the activity are as follows:
 - a. To orient school-based stakeholders on the principles, structure, and content of the LSCP as outlined in DepEd Order No. 22, s. 2024;
 - b. To facilitate the development, review, and validation of school-based LSCPs aligned with the School Improvement Plan (SIP) Implementation Plan (AIP);
 - c. To promote inclusive, context-based, and resilient education planning responsive to emergencies; and
 - d. To identify risk-informed strategies ensuring learning continuity for all learners, especially those in vulnerable sectors.
- 3. The participants to this activity are members of the School DRRM Team, preferably composed of the following:
 - Public Schools District Supervisors (PSDSs)
 - School Heads (SHs)
 - Teacher Representatives per School
 - Parent Representatives per School
 - Representatives from the Barangay (BLGU)

- 4. Each participating **school** is advised to bring at least one (1) laptop to be used during the workshop sessions.
- 5. A registration fee of Php 400.00 per participant shall be paid to the Division Cashier on or before August 11, 2025, which may be sourced from School MOOE or Local Funds, subject to usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations. The amount shall cover meals of the School Heads, Teacher Representatives and Barangay participants.
- 6. Wide dissemination and strict compliance with this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
