REITERATION ON THE REVITALIZATION OF SCOUTING MOVEMENT IN THE SCHOOLS DIVISION OFFICE OF ANGELES CITY

- 1. Scouting is a nationally recognized school-integrated youth development program that provides useful life skills, fosters citizenship, and builds character in order to support holistic development. The Department of Education supports it as a formal co-curricular program. More than just an extracurricular activity, the Philippine Scouting movement is a structured educational program that works with schools to develop the country's youth into well-behaved, independent, and civic-minded adults.
- 2. This Office recognizes the significant role that scouting plays in shaping learners into responsible and engaged members of society, while also enhancing quality education initiatives. Scouting as a co-curricular activity, helps learners to divert away from negative influences like drug use and harmful peer pressure. Therefore, active participation of all learners in scouting programs, activities, and projects should be highly encouraged and supported within schools.
- 3. In support, this office reiterates the revitalization of scouting program in all public and private schools in various areas possible for partnership and cooperation consistent with the following guidelines:
 - 3.1 Membership Promotion and Registration. School Heads are encouraged to be members of the boy or girl scout movement. School officials, teachers, and personnel shall support and promote the scouting advancement system and badges. Integration of scouting principles and activities into school events, curriculum where possible, and community engagements shall be promoted.
 - 3.2 Participation in Scouting Activities. Learners, school officials, and personnel are encouraged to participate in scouting activities including jamborees, camps, trainings, competitions, and conferences at the school,









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- division, regional, and national levels. Wearing of scout uniforms or neckerchiefs during official scouting activities and designated scout uniform days is encouraged to build visibility and positive image.
- 3.3 Health and Safety Protocols. All scouting activities shall comply with current DepEd and Schools Division Office health and safety guidelines to ensure the welfare of participants.
- 3.4 Implementation and Monitoring. The Division BSP and GSP Coordinators shall regularly monitor the implementation, submit reports to the Schools Division Office, and recommend improvements.
