BATCHES 4 AND 5 TRAINING ON TRAINERS METHODOLOGY LEVEL I AND COMPETENCY ASSESSORS' ACCREDITATION FOR SHS-TVL, JHS-SPTVE, AND JHS-TLE TEACHERS

- In line with the Five-Point Agenda's thrust to enhance teacher welfare, the Department of Education Regional Office III (DepEd RO III), through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division (CLMD) and the Human Resource Development Division (HRDD)-National Educators Academy of the Philippines-III (NEAP-III), reaffirms its commitment to advancing teacher professional growth through continuous capacity building. Accordingly, the Regional Office will conduct the Training on Trainers Methodology (TM) Level I and Competency Assessors' Accreditation for SHS-TVL, JHS-SPTVE, and JHS-TLE teachers (Batches 4 and 5) in partnership with TESDA-accredited training centers within the region.
- The training aims to equip teachers with the competencies required of Technical-Vocational Trainers under TESDA's Training Regulations for TM Level I. Likewise, the Competency Assessors' Accreditation seeks to strengthen schools' capacity to deliver high-quality training and assessment aligned with TESDA standards. This initiative supports a sustainable professional development cycle, enabling certified assessors to mentor and evaluate future TM I trainees, thereby addressing existing training gaps.
- The 33-day professional development training shall be conducted as follows: 3.

October 27 – 31, 2025, and November 3 – 7, 2025 at Anne Raquels Hillside Resort and Hotel, Olongapo City November 10 – 22, 2025 via Zoom/MS Team platform.
November 25 – December 4, 2025, at Anne Raquels Hillside Resort and Hotel, Olongapo City

A total of 120 SHS-TVL, JHS-SPTVE, and JHS-TLE teachers (Batch 4 - 70; Batch 5 - 50) shall be the participants of this training. They are required to bring their laptops, chargers, and extension cords during all face-to-face sessions.

- 5. The Competency Assessments (COC 1 and 2) for TM Level I will be administered to the 120 teacher-participants by December 2025. In addition, 75 teachers under the Competency Assessors' Accreditation program shall coordinate with their respective TESDA Provincial Offices for loading and assessment from October to December 2025.
- 6. Participants of the TM Level I training must submit the following **TESDA entry requirements** to the training secretariat upon registration on October 26, 2025:
 - a. Duly accomplished and signed Learner's profile (see Enclosure 1)
 - b. 2 pcs 1x1 picture
 - c. 2 pcs passport size picture white background with collar
 - d. Photocopy of Birth Certificate
 - e. Photocopy of Marriage Certificate (for married women)
 - f. Barangay clearance
 - g. Medical Certificate (physically and mentally fit)
 - h. Photocopy of National Certificates
- 7. Furthermore, the 120 participants in the TM Level I training and 75 participants in the Competency Assessors' Accreditation shall submit the following documents on or before October 24, 2025:
 - a. Personal Profile Sheet
 - b. Letter of Intent
 - c. Notarized Scholarship Contract (for TM Level I only)
 - d. Undertaking
 - e. Certified Photocopy of National Certificates/TM I Certificates

Hard copies shall be endorsed to the **Regional Office III – Human Resource Development Division (HRDD)**, while soft copies shall be uploaded through this link: https://tinyurl.com/5cmpk2hv

- 8. To ensure training effectiveness using the Kirkpatrick Model, all 195 participants (120 TM Level I and 75 Assessors' Accreditation) must pass the Competency Assessment and prepare a Work Application Project/Plan at the end of the 33-day program. The TLE Education Program Supervisors of the Schools Division Offices (SDOs) shall monitor and evaluate these outputs.
- 9. Expenses related to the training including board and lodging, travel expenses, registration fees, assessment fees, training supplies and materials, and internet allowance of participants shall be charged against RO downloaded funds. Travel expenses of resource persons, training managers and assistants, and NEAP representatives shall be covered through direct payment, subject to existing auditing rules and regulations. The Regional Office may develop mechanisms to ensure efficient implementation.

- 10. Teacher-participants shall be entitled to Service Credits in accordance with DepEd Order No. 013, s. 2024 ("Revised Guidelines on the Grant of Vacation Service Credits for Teachers"). Non-teaching personnel, including Division Chiefs, may avail of Compensatory Time-Off (CTO) pursuant to CSC-DBM Joint Circular No. 2, s. 2004 ("Non-Monetary Remuneration for Overtime Services Rendered"). All offices are enjoined to support their scholars' participation, ensuring compliance with the No Disruption of Classes Policy.
- 11. Check-in and registration for participants will be on the afternoon of October 26, 2025, November 2, 2025 and November 24, 2025 (Day 0). Check-out will be on October 31, 2025, November 7, 2025, and December 4, 2025, for Phases 1 and 3, respectively. The Opening Program will be on October 26, 2025, at 3:00 p.m. at Anne Raquels Hillside Resort and Hotel, Olongapo City. 

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

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
