REGIONAL ENGAGEMENT ACTIVITY ON MARITIME AWARENESS AND WEST PHILIPPINE SEA EDUCATION

- 1. The West Philippine Sea is of critical national importance in terms of maritime security, resource management, environmental protection, and the welfare of coastal communities. At the same time, basic education institutions have a role in fostering maritime awareness and civic consciousness among learners. In recognition of this, the Department of Education Region III (DepEd-Region III) and the Philippine Coast Guard West Philippine Sea Transparency Group (PCG-WPSTG), shall undertake a joint engagement activity on November 8, 2025, at Robinsons Starmills Pampanga, City of San Fernando (P).

- 4. The PCG-WPSTG will provide meals (lunch and P.M. snacks) STG. At the same time, transportation expenses of all participants shall be charged to local funds, subject to the government accounting and auditing rules and regulations.




