DIVISION TRAINING FOR SCHOOL HEADS: ECHOING BEST PRACTICES AND ADDRESSING CHALLENGES IN INSTRUCTIONAL LEADERSHIP

- 1. This is to inform the field of the conduct of the Division Training for School Heads: Echoing Best Practices and Addressing Challenges in Instructional Leadership on November 25-27, 2025, 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m. at the Gabaldon Building, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
- 2. The objectives of the training are the following:
 - Analyze key instructional leadership practices that have led to improved learner outcomes across diverse school contexts.
 - Reflect on current challenges faced by school heads—such as administrative overload, role ambiguity, and limited instructional time—and identify adaptive strategies to address them.
 - Apply the Philippine Professional Standards for School Heads (PPSSH) to real-world leadership scenarios, focusing on strategic leadership and teaching and learning domains.
 - Demonstrate effective techniques in instructional supervision, including classroom observation, coaching and feedback, and SLAC facilitation.
 - Design a Personal Leadership Action Plan (PLAP) aligned with school realities, PPSSH indicators, and NEAP-recognized CPD pathways.
- 3. Participants in this training are the Public Schools District Supervisors, School Principals, Assistant School Principals, and select Head Teachers. They are required to bring laptops and extension cords.
- 4. Meals of the participants shall be charged to HRTD Funds.
