5. Wide dissemination of and strict compliance to the contents of this Memorandum are highly enjoined.

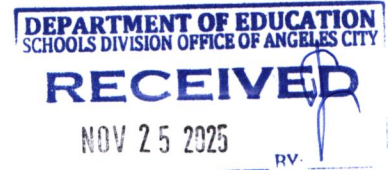
