**CONDUCT OF THE SUPREME ELEMENTARY LEARNER GOVERNMENT (SELG)
 ELECTIONS FOR SCHOOL YEAR 2026-2027**

- DepEd Order No. 12, s.2025** entitled “Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities”, provides the schedule for the conduct of Learner Government Elections. Specifically, under Enclosure, Section V: General Guidelines, Item G, states that, “ The school-based elections for the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) shall take place immediately after the **3rd Quarter Examination**, with a two-week period allocated for preparation, campaigning, and voting, Following these elections another two weeks shall be designated for planning and conducting the Division and Regional Federation Elections”.
- For appropriate guidance, the SELG election shall be conducted following the indicative schedule outlined below:

Activity	Suggested Dates
School-Based Elections	Within January 26 – February 13, 2026
Division Elections	February 20, 2026
Regional Elections	Within March 9-27, 2026 (Venue shall be announced in a separate Memorandum)
National Federation Election	To be announced in a separate Memorandum

- Public Schools are requested to adhere to the prescribed guidelines; however, revision and enhancement of the guidelines may be done through a form of resolution to address the school’s specific context and needs.

Pursuant to Department of Education Order No. 12, s. 2025, titled "Multi-Year Implementing Guidelines on the School Calendar and Activities," the Department recognizes the Learner Government Program (LGP) as the foremost co-curricular learner-led organization authorized to implement pertinent programs, projects, and activities in all schools nationwide.

The establishment of the Supreme Elementary Learner Government (SELG) and Supreme Secondary Learner Government (SSLG) in all elementary and secondary schools nationwide is pivotal in fostering leadership skills and empowering learners to actively participate in school governance. This provides an opportunity for learners to assume leadership roles but also highlight the significance of learner-led clubs and organizations in promoting a vibrant school culture.

Anchored on the mission to amplify learners' voices in decision-making and to ensure their perspectives inform educational policies, the Bureau of Learner Support Services (BLSS), through the Youth Formation Division (YFD), remains committed to supporting learners in developing leadership skills that contribute to their holistic growth and development.

In this regard, the BLSS-YFD respectfully reiterate the conduct of the SELG and SSLG elections for School Year (S.Y.) 2026-2027, as supported by the following provisions in the same DepEd Order stated above:

- The school-based elections for the SELG and SSLG shall take place immediately after the 3rd Quarter Examination, with a two-week period allocated for preparation, campaigning, and voting.



- Following these elections, another two weeks shall be designated for planning and conducting the District, Division, and Regional Federation elections.
- The schedule and guidelines for the National Federation of Supreme Secondary Learner Government (NFSSLG) elections shall be announced in a separate issuance.
- After the SELG and SSLG elections, the school's Commission on Elections and Appointments (COMEAA) shall oversee the elections of other recognized clubs and organizations.

For appropriate guidance, the SELG and SSLG elections may be conducted following the indicative schedule as outlined below:

Activity	Suggested Dates
School-Based Elections	January 26-30; February 2-13, 2026
District-Division Elections	February 16-27; March 2-6, 2026
Regional Federation Elections	March 9-27, 2026
National Federation Elections	<i>To be announced in a separate memorandum</i>

To ensure optimal engagement of all learners, all Regional Directors (RDs), Schools Division Superintendents (SDSs), and School Heads, through their respective Youth Formation Coordinators (YFCs) and SELG/SSLG Advisers, are requested to provide technical assistance during the conduct of these activities.

Furthermore, pending the approval of the revised Constitution and By-Laws of the Learner Government Program (LGP), schools are advised to refer to the previously issued guidelines which may be accessed via: <https://tinyurl.com/LGP2026-2027>.

Implementing schools are required to adhere to the prescribed guidelines but are encouraged to revise or enhance them through a formal resolution, to align with the school's specific context and needs.
