**CONDUCT OF BASIC LIFE SUPPORT (BLS) TRAINING
FOR SCHOOL EMERGENCY RESPONSE**

1. Republic Act No. 10871, otherwise known as the *Basic Life Support Training in Schools Act*, mandates the provision of Basic Life Support (BLS) training to teachers and school personnel to ensure timely and effective emergency response in school settings. In support of this law, the Department of Education issued DepEd Order No. 54, s. 2021, which provides policy guidelines on strengthening school safety and disaster preparedness through capacity-building activities on first aid and life-saving skills.
2. In line with these national policies, this Office with its commitment to school safety, disaster preparedness, and resilience shall conduct a **Basic Life Support (BLS) Training for School Emergency Response**, to be implemented in **two (2) batches on January 22 and 28, 2026**, in partnership with the Angeles City DRRM Office and AUF-College of Nursing Alumni Association. The training shall be held at the **Gabaldon Building, Angeles City**, from **8:00 AM to 5:00 PM**.
3. The objectives of the training are:
 - a) To equip participants with knowledge and skills on cardiopulmonary resuscitation (CPR), choking management, and basic emergency response;
 - b) To strengthen school-level preparedness for medical and life-threatening emergencies; and
 - c) To institutionalize a culture of safety and readiness in schools in compliance with RA 10871 and DepEd Order No. 54, s. 2021.
4. The participants shall be composed of two (2) teaching and non-teaching personnel representatives from each public school and select Division personnel, who meet the following criteria:
 - Must be permanent teaching or non-teaching personnel who are not for transfer to other school;
 - Physically fit to perform CPR and other emergency interventions;



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- With no medical restrictions that would prevent participation in hands-on training (e.g., severe back problems or mobility limitations);
 - Preferably within working age and physically capable, as assessed by the School Head;
 - Personnel who have previously attended first-aid or emergency response training may still participate for refresher purposes;
 - Willing to attend the full-day training, including lectures, hands-on demonstrations, and practical assessments;
 - Committed to applying learned skills in school emergencies and drills; and
 - Priority shall be given to school first responders, such as teachers on duty, health personnel, and members of the School Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (SDRRM) Team.
5. Enclose are the consent form to be submitted on or before January 20, 2026 to the SGOD Office and schedule of school-participants.
6. Meals and training materials shall be provided by AUF-CON AA.
7. Immediate and wide dissemination of this Memorandum is earnestly desired.
