**Implementing Guidelines and Mechanics of the DIVISION ALIVE QUIZ BEE
2026**

The category components, number of learner-participants and teacher-coaches, and time allotment for ALIVE Quiz bee are provided as follows:

Category	Event	No. of Learner-Participant	No. of Teacher-Coach	Time Allotment
Elementary	ALIVE Quiz Bee	3	1	45 minutes

General Guidelines:

1. The contest is open to all learners in the Schools Division of Angeles City who are enrolled and tagged in LIS as ALIVE learners in the current school year.
2. Participants should have registered and complied with the following requirements before the activity:
 - a. Parents' Consent;
 - b. Accomplished Entry Form;
 - c. School Form 10 (for Verification);
 - d. School ID
3. Any participant who fails to comply with the requirements and the qualifications specific to each category shall be disqualified.
4. Filled out entry form should be submitted at least one week before the conduct of the activity.
5. The teams shall be given a control number to conceal the school they represent.
6. Winners in each category shall receive medals and a certificate of recognition for 1st to 3rd places.
7. Winning coaches shall receive a certificate of recognition.
8. All participating schools will be given a certificate of participation.
9. Only official coaches can file an appeal with the judges if there are any concerns.
10. The decision of the judges is final and irrevocable.

PERFORMANCE STANDARD	The learners demonstrate comprehensive knowledge and understanding of Islamic values, Arabic language, Qur'anic verses, Ahādīth, Islamic history, and jurisprudence aligned with the ALIVE curriculum while exhibiting critical thinking, quick recall skills, and teamwork.	
DESCRIPTION	ALIVE Quiz Bee is an NFOT event category of Musabaqah that tests learners' comprehensive knowledge of Islamic education through team collaboration. The competition consists of multiple rounds covering various topics from the Grades 1 to 6 ALIVE curriculum, including Qur'anic verses and their meanings, Ahādīth, Islamic history (Sirah), the Five Pillars of Islam, the Six Articles of Faith, basic Fiqh, Arabic vocabulary, and Islamic values. Teams of three work together, combining their knowledge and critical thinking to answer questions.

<p><i>Mechanics of the ALIVE Quiz Bee</i></p> <p>A. There shall be three participants per school forming one team.</p> <p>B. There must be one representative from each grade level in the key stage, male or female.</p>		



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C. During the contest proper, the team shall be seated at the designated table with their meta-cards and permanent markers.

D. The competition consists of three rounds:

- Easy Round: 10 standard multiple-choice questions
- Average Round: 10 standard multiple-choice questions
- Difficult Round: 5 constructed response questions

E. The school shall:

- Submit three questions with an answer key for each round
- Questions shall be accompanied by a table of specifications (TOS)

F. For each question:

- The question shall be read twice.
- The teams shall start writing after hearing the word "*uktubu*".
- Time limits:
 - o Easy Round: 10 seconds per question
 - o Average Round: 15 seconds per question
 - o Difficult Round: 30 seconds per question

G. The teams shall immediately raise their meta-cards after the buzzer.

H. The scores shall be summed up after each round and posted on the tally board/score board.

I. In case of appeal, any of the team members or the official coach may raise the question/clarification immediately after the item before the next question is read. Queries/clarifications done after the entire contest shall not be entertained.

J. The three teams with the highest total points shall be declared winners.

K. In case of a tie:

- a. A clincher round shall be conducted between the tied participants only.
- b. Clincher round procedure:
 - The judges shall prepare a separate set of questions specifically for potential clincher rounds.
 - Questions will be given one at a time from these clincher questions.
 - Each question follows the same format: read twice, 30 seconds to write the correct answers.



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- Each correct answer earns 1 point.
 - The first team to score 3 points shall be declared the winner for that ranking.
 - If no team reaches 3 points after 5 questions, the team with the highest points in the clincher round wins.
- a. If still tied after 5 questions, do or die round begins, where the first team to answer correctly wins.
- b. Separate clincher rounds shall be conducted for each tied ranking (i.e., if there is a tie for both first and second place).
