**DISSEMINATION AND CONDUCT OF THE SCHOOL ZONE
AND ROAD SAFETY RISK ASSESSMENT IN ALL PUBLIC SCHOOLS**

To : Assistant Schools Division Superintendent
Chief Education Supervisors
Public Schools District Supervisors
Public Elementary and Secondary School Heads
All Others Concerned

1. The Schools Division Office of Angeles City through SGOD-DRRM's alignment on **Project SAFER** will conduct the **School Zone and Road Safety Risk Assessment in all Public Schools**, which aims to identify hazards, assess risks, and determine priority interventions related to school safety zones, security measures, and road safety conditions, particularly during learner arrival and dismissal periods.
2. The objectives are to:
 - a. Assess the current condition of school safety zones, security arrangements, and road safety measures;
 - b. Identify gaps, hazards, and priority needs affecting learner and personnel safety;
 - c. Support evidence-based planning under **Project SAFER** and **LOVE is SAFER** initiatives; and
 - d. Strengthen coordination with partner agencies such as LGUs, Barangays, PNP, ACTDO, and ACDRRMO.
3. Enclosed is the School Zone and Road Safety Risk Assessment Tool for reference.
4. The Division DRRM Coordinator, Youth Formation Coordinators, Angeles City DRRM Office and Angeles City Traffic and Development Office Representatives shall conduct the school zone and road safety risk assessment on **January 23, 26, 27, 29 & 30, 2026**.
5. Expenses, if any, incidental to the conduct of the assessment shall be charged against 2025 DPRP funds, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
