SUPPORT TO THE INTENSIFIED ENFORCEMENT OF ANTI-LITTERING LAW IN ANGELES CITY

1. Pursuant to the directive of the City Government of Angeles and in compliance with City Ordinance No. 431 (Amended Environmental Code of Angeles City), Chapter 3, Section 30(a), the Schools Division Office of Angeles City shall fully support and implement the intensified enforcement of Anti-Littering within all schools and learning institutions under its jurisdiction.
2. The following are the key aspects of enforcement being implemented by the City Government of Angeles City through EMS and CENRO:
 - 2.1 The campaign covers littering in public spaces, throwing trash from vehicles, and illegal dumping of solid waste, as well as violations of the city's environmental code.
 - 2.2 Strict monitoring of public spaces is being implemented, with expansion city-wide, including areas around major establishments and barangays.
3. The following are the Division Directives to be observed by all schools under the jurisdiction of the Schools Division Office of Angeles City:
 - 3.1 School Heads are directed to strictly enforce anti-littering policies within school premises, consistent with the provisions of City Ordinance No. 431.
 - 3.2 Conduct information dissemination among teachers, learners, and personnel regarding prohibited acts such as littering, throwing trash from vehicles, and illegal dumping of solid waste.

- 3.3. Environmental discipline shall be integrated into school activities, classroom discussions, and student organizations to instill responsibility and civic awareness.

4. The cooperation of all concerned is enjoined to ensure the success of this initiative and to foster a culture of discipline, cleanliness, and environmental responsibility among learners and stakeholders.
