2. The activity aims to orient select SDO personnel and school heads on the latest updates of Learning Systems reform policies.

3. The participants are the Assistant Schools Division Superintendent, SGOD, and CID Chief Education Supervisors, CID Supervisors, Education Program Specialist II for SMM&E, Planning Officer, IT Officer, Project Development Officer II (LRMS), Public School Heads in the elementary and secondary schools (JHS and SHS), Head Teachers in the elementary schools and School Administrators from Private Schools.

4. School Administrators from private schools are encouraged to attend online while participants from Schools Division Office and Public Schools are required to attend onsite at the Gabaldon Building.

5. The orientation link for the Private School Administrators will be sent to their respective email addresses.

6. Meal expenses incurred in the attendance of the participants shall be charged against the Division MOOE for SDO personnel, while the meal expenses of school personnel shall be charged against the School MOOE, Local Funds, or other authorized fund sources of their respective schools, subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

7. Payment for the meal expenses amounting to Four Hundred Pesos (P 400) per participant shall be paid directly to the Cash Office on or before April 29, 2026.

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

DATE : 26 April 2026

1. Following the agreements from the previous orientation sessions with the Regional Offices (ROs) and Schools Division Offices (SDOs), this memorandum is issued to provide guidance on the conduct of the **Online Orientation on Learning Systems Policies for School Heads in Regions II, III, and X** scheduled on April 29, 2026 from 9:00 AM to 4:00 PM as detailed in the *Enclosure*.
2. The orientation will be conducted online via a **YouTube livestream**. The livestream link will be shared with regional focal persons on April 28, 2026.
3. ROs are directed to organize **clustered viewing sessions**. School heads should gather in groups at a designated location to watch the livestream and complete the orientation activities together. ROs must submit the consolidated list of clustered viewing stations and their focal persons via email at ouct@deped.gov.ph.
4. Each RO must assign a technical team to set up the technical requirements for the clustered viewing session. The technical team must ensure the following are available:
 - a. A screen and speakers for group viewing
 - b. One device with a camera and a microphone for interaction with the session
 - c. Internet access for all participants
5. Only one device from the technical team will be allowed backstage for the livestream.

6. All technical team members responsible for setting up a clustered viewing station are required to participate in a tech run on April 28.
7. ROs must provide participants with the orientation handouts during the event. The handouts are available for download here: <https://bit.ly/WorksheetsFromLS>
8. School heads attending the orientation are advised to bring the following:
 - a. **A mobile device with internet access**, for participation in the interactive sessions
 - b. **Pens** for filling out the activity sheets
9. ROs and SDOs shall oversee the conduct of clustered viewing activities and ensure the active participation of school heads during the workshop. Feedback from all participants shall be consolidated by the RO and forwarded to the Central Office upon completion of the event.
