**CALL FOR NOMINATION FOR THE 2027 PRINCESS MAHA CHAKRI AWARD**

1. Pursuant to **Memorandum DM-OUHRODI-2026-1366** relative to the nationwide call for nomination for the **2027 Princess Maha Chakri Award (PMCA)**, this Office announces the opening of nominations for qualified teacher nominees from the Schools Division Office of Angeles City.
2. The **Princess Maha Chakri Award (PMCA)** is an international award established in honor of Her Royal Highness Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn of Thailand in recognition of outstanding teachers whose exemplary dedication and innovations have significantly transformed the lives of learners and contributed to educational development.
3. The award aims to recognize teachers who:
  - a. demonstrates exceptional commitment to teaching and learning;
  - b. creates meaningful impact on learners, especially those in disadvantaged communities;
  - c. initiates innovative practices and community-based educational programs; and
  - d. inspires fellow educators and stakeholders through exemplary leadership and service.
4. All public elementary and secondary schools are encouraged to nominate one (1) deserving teacher who meets the qualifications and criteria stipulated in DM-OUHRODI-2026-1366 and related PMCA guidelines.
5. The documentary requirements shall include, but are not limited to, the following:
  - Endorsement letter from the School Head;
  - Updated Personal Data Sheet (PDS);
  - Service Record;
  - Narrative report of accomplishments and innovations;
  - Portfolio of supporting documents and evidence;
  - Certificates of recognition/awards;
  - Other documents required in the attached national guidelines.



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6. School nominees shall undergo screening and evaluation at the Division Level based on the prescribed PMCA selection criteria and procedures. The Division-selected nominee shall then be endorsed to the Regional Office for further evaluation.
7. All concerned schools shall submit the complete nomination documents in both printed and soft copy formats to the Human Resource Development Unit on or before **May 18, 2026**.
8. Enclosed is **Memorandum DM-OUHRODI-2026-1366** for reference and guidance.
9. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are desired.



1. The Department of Education (DepEd), through the International Cooperation Office (ICO) and HRODI Strand, hereby disseminates the enclosed **Call for Nominations for the 2027 Princess Maha Chakri Award (PMCA)**. The Philippines has engaged in this initiative since 2015 to honor the legacy of Her Royal Highness (HRH) Princess Maha Chakri Sirindhorn of Thailand. The PMCA confers international recognition upon dedicated educators across 14 participating countries, comprising ASEAN member states, Timor-Leste, Bangladesh, Bhutan, and Mongolia, whose outstanding contributions have significantly advanced education and human development.
2. The PMCA is given **biennially** to active teachers or educational administrators who have positively changed students' lives and inspired fellow educators. For the Philippines, the Screening Committee shall evaluate nominees **based on the following criteria**:
  - Participation in community and civic movements, especially where education is least accessible;
  - Innovation in teaching that has benefited communities where the nominee has taught;
  - Ability to inspire, promote, and sustain the development of students and fellow teachers through their dedication.
3. Please be guided with the **Philippine Screening Process**:
  - **Selection Committee**: Composed of the Undersecretary for HROD, Director IV of BHROD, Assistant Secretary of the International Cooperation Office (ICO), and Director IV of the National Educators Academy of the Philippines (NEAP).
  - **Regional Submissions**: Each Regional Office (RO) shall submit one (1) nominee to the DepEd Central Office.

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- **Deliberation:** The Selection Committee of DepEd CO will deliberate on the 17 total nominations.
  - **Approval:** The Secretary approves the selected awardee, whose profile is then submitted to the PMCA Foundation.
4. Interested and qualified teacher applicants must submit the following pertinent documents to their respective **Schools Division Offices (SDOs)**:
- a. Updated **Personal Data Sheet** (CS Form 212);
  - b. **1,500-word essay** written by the applicant on why he/she should receive the Award;
  - c. **Letter of nomination from the DepEd SDO** addressed to the Regional Director, signed and endorsed by the Schools Division Superintendent (SDS);
  - d. **Accomplished Matrix (Annex B)** of activities, awards, and accomplishments relevant to the award, accompanied with supporting documents (Note: Please spell out all acronyms of organizers and topics/subjects of training. Training certificates need not be submitted).
5. The DepEd ROs are requested to forward their final nominee's requirements to the DepEd International Cooperation Office (ICO) on or before **May 31, 2026**.
