1. Pursuant to Regional Memorandum No. 076, s. 2026 titled "Project SAKTONG ALS: Summer Program on Micro-certification for Professional and Resilient ALS Learners," this Office announces the conduct of the said program on May 25, 2026, at the Gabaldon Building, Pulung Bulu, Angeles City.
2. This initiative utilizes the post-exam "waiting window" for Accreditation and Equivalency (A&E) results to provide ALS learners with industry-aligned skills. The program focuses on the *Sakto Skills Series*, offering micro-learning sessions in work readiness and climate resilience.
3. The activity aims to:
 - a. Provide ALS learners opportunities to develop life skills such as resilience, adaptability, and problem-solving through LEaP! Program and Sakto Skills Serye;
 - b. strengthen work readiness through professional competencies recognized via micro-certification; and
 - c. strengthen the partnership between DepEd Region III and UNICEF/ALTEC for future scaling.
4. Participants in this activity are the 133 ALS learners and 22 personnel, consisting of the SDO of Angeles City ALS teachers, BAE/Region III representatives, and UNICEF facilitators.
5. Expenses relative to the conduct of this activity shall be charged against Program Support Funds (Sub-Allotment Release Order No: DepEd -ROIII-2026-04-0464), subject to the usual accounting and auditing rules and regulations.

4. Each identified SDO is expected to **pool a total of 136 participants**, composed of 128 ALS learner-participants, five (5) Technical Working Group members, and three (3) resource persons.

 - b. Strengthen work readiness by developing professional competencies and transferable skills recognized through micro-certification; and
 - c. Strengthened partnership between DepEd Region III and UNICEF/ALTEC for future scaling.
6. Expenses for meals, snacks, supplies, and materials for the one-day activity shall be charged to the ALS Program Support Funds (PSF) to be downloaded to the SDOs, subject to existing accounting and auditing rules and regulations.
