**ORIENTATION ON THE LEARNER'S GUIDE FOR THE WATER, SANITATION,
AND HYGIENE IN SCHOOLS (WinS) PROGRAM**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent

1. Pursuant to DepEd Order No. 10, s. 2016, entitled Policy and Guidelines for the Comprehensive Water, Sanitation, and Hygiene (WASH) in Schools (WinS) Program, quality standards for water, sanitation, hygiene, deworming, and health education are established. The program aims to promote proper hygiene and sanitation practices among learners and ensure a clean, safe, and healthy school environment.

2. The WinS Program adopts the Three Star Approach (TSA), an integrated system for monitoring, quality assurance, and performance recognition. As outlined in DepEd Memorandum No. 194, s. 2018, the TSA supports continuous improvement and measurable outcomes in schools.

3. In line with this, the Schools Division Office of Angeles City, through the School Governance and Operations Division (SGOD) – School Health and Nutrition Unit (SHNU), in partnership with Good People International (GPI), will conduct an Orientation on the Learner's Guide for the WinS Program.

4. The participants are the School Health and Nutrition Unit personnel, School Heads, Administrative Officers II, and the Head Teachers assigned to the WinS Program from the following schools:

- Anunas Elementary School
- Gueco Balibago Elementary School
- Marisol Bliss Elementary School
- Bonifacio V. Romero High School – Junior High School
- Northville 15 Integrated School

5. The orientation shall be held on **June 19, 2026, from 8:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m.**, at the Gabaldon Building, Pulungbulu, Angeles City.
