**OBSERVANCE OF THE NATIONAL DISASTER  
RESILIENCE MONTH (NDRM) 2026**

To: Assistant Schools Division Superintendent  
Chiefs, CID and SGOD  
Public Schools District Supervisors  
School Heads of Public and Private Elementary and Secondary Schools  
All Concerned

1. In compliance with Executive Order No. 29, s.2017 declaring the month of July of every year as the **National Disaster Resilience Month (NDRM)**, the Schools Division Office of Angeles City joins the nation in promoting a culture of resilience through strengthened awareness, preparedness, prevention, mitigation, response, rehabilitation, and recovery initiatives.

2. This year's observance is particularly significant in light of the recent incidents that have underscored the importance of ensuring safe, secure, and resilient learning environments.

3. In this regard, and pursuant to **DepEd Order No. 09, s. 2026** on the uninterrupted conduct of classes and learning continuity, schools are encouraged to conduct meaningful, inclusive, safe, and classroom-based or school-based activities that promote disaster resilience without disrupting regular instructional time. Suggested activities include, but are not limited to:

- a) Flag Ceremony messages and advocacy on disaster resilience, school safety, and emergency preparedness;
- b) Poster-making, slogan-making, digital poster, essay writing, or multimedia advocacy contests;
- c) Quiz Bees, learning sessions, and classroom discussions on Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (DRRM), Climate Change Adaptation and Mitigation (CCAM), school safety, and emergency preparedness;
- d) Integration of DRRM, climate resilience, school safety, and security education across learning areas;
- e) Utilization of the **Master of Disaster (MOD)** Board Game and other interactive DRRM learning resources;
- f) Gulayan sa Paaralan, tree-growing, urban gardening, waste segregation, and environmental stewardship activities;
- g) School-based DRRM advocacy campaigns through official school social media platforms and information dissemination activities;
- h) Clean and Green, school clean-up drives, and hazard reduction activities;



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- i) Roll-out of Inclusive Child-Centered Disaster Risk Reduction and Management (ICDRRM) initiatives;
- j) Strengthening learner participation through the **Batang Empowered and Resilient Team (BERT)**, student-led School Watching, hazard mapping, risk identification, and preparedness activities;
- k) Orientation and awareness sessions on emergency preparedness for earthquakes, fires, severe weather disturbances, flooding, heat-related illnesses, violence prevention, school security, and other emerging hazards; and
- l) Conduct of emergency preparedness drills, tabletop exercises, or simulations, as appropriate and in accordance with existing DepEd and national DRRM policies.

4. All activities shall strictly adhere to existing DepEd policies on learner safety, child protection, school security, and disaster risk reduction management. Schools shall likewise ensure that activities are inclusive, age-appropriate, gender-responsive, disability-inclusive, and compliant with health and safety protocols.

5. Schools shall submit a brief narrative report with photographs and documentation of their National Disaster Resilience Month activities to the Division DRRM Coordinator on or before **31 July 2026** for consolidation and submission to the Regional and Central Offices.

6. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum is desired.
