The **38th Milo[®] Marathon- Angeles City Qualifying Race** will be held on **July 20, 2014** at the SM City Clark (Start to Finish and Staging Grounds) to CDC grounds (Race Route). Race will start at **6:00 AM**.

This race is organized by RUNRIO, Inc. and Angeles City Government, headed by Mayor Edgardo D. Pamintuan and Councilor Jericho G. Aguas, as the LGU partner for the local leg. The qualifying race is in line with the celebration of the 50th Anniversary of the cityhood of Angeles.


The **Milo[®] Marathon** has various activities that can be participated in: 3K Kiddie Run, 5K Fun Run, Biggest School Delegation Competition, Inter-school Running Competition, and Cheer Leading Competition.

Trophies, medals and cash prizes will be given to the top finishers in the qualifying race while in the side events competition trophies and sports equipment will be awarded.

In this regard, public elementary and secondary teacher-coaches and athletes are encouraged to participate in this event to promote the pupils/students physical and well-being. **Participation is on a voluntary basis.**

Furthermore, public elementary and secondary schools athletes are required to secure parental consent before they will be allowed to register and compete. Teacher-Coaches are also required to accompany their athletes during and after the competition proper.
