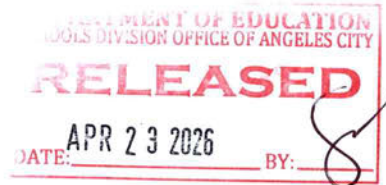

2. The reassignment or designation initiative aims to promote the sharing of educational leadership and effective management practices, as well as to strengthen collaboration and professional relationships among stakeholders across schools and governance levels.
3. All School Principals and OIC School Head who are reassigned or designated to another school are required to submit their respective clearances to the Personnel Unit on or before April 27, 2026. The official turnover of duties and responsibilities shall take place on **April 28, 2026**, to be facilitated by the concerned Public Schools District Supervisors, in coordination with the Chief, ES-CID.
4. Teachers and non-teaching personnel of the concerned schools are hereby enjoined to extend full cooperation and support to the newly designated or reassigned School Principals, as well as to those designated as OIC Principals.
5. Immediate dissemination of and strict compliance with this Memorandum are hereby directed.
