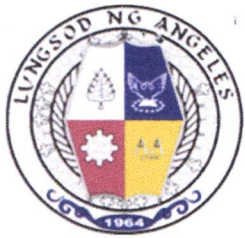
Participation of all public secondary schools shall be subject to the approval of the School Principal and the written consent of the parents or legal guardians of participating learners.

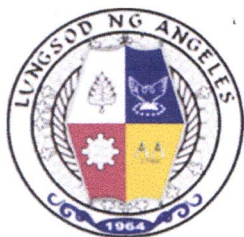

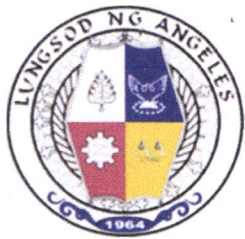

Quiz Bee Competition Mechanics

Senior High School Category

The **Quiz Bee Competition** is one of the official events of the **Linggo ng Kabataan 2026** Celebration of the **City Government of Angeles**, through the **Angeles City Youth Development Office (ACYDO)**, in partnership with the **Schools Division Office of Angeles City (SDO Angeles)**. The competition aims to promote academic excellence, critical thinking, media and information literacy, teamwork, and healthy competition among Senior High School students in Angeles City.

Competition Mechanics

1. The competition is open to all **public Senior High Schools** within the City of Angeles.
2. Each participating school shall be allowed to send **one (1) team** composed of **three (3) bona fide Senior High School students** currently enrolled in Grades 11 or 12.
3. Each participating school shall officially register its team by submitting the **accomplished Official Entry Form (attached)** on or before **August 10, 2026**, through the official email address of the Angeles City Youth Development Office (ACYDO): acydo.official@gmail.com. The Entry Form must be duly certified by the School Principal or the designated School Representative. Incomplete or late submissions may be disqualified.
4. All participants, coaches, and advisers shall report to the official venue **at least thirty (30) minutes before** the scheduled start of the competition for registration and orientation.
5. The Organizing Committee shall provide each team with the necessary competition materials, including a whiteboard, marker, and eraser.
6. The Quiz Bee shall consist of **three (3) rounds**:
 - **Easy Round** – Ten (10) questions
 - **Average Round** – Seven (7) questions
 - **Difficult Round** – Five (5) questions

A total of **twenty-two (22) questions** shall be asked throughout the competition.

Coverage of the Questions

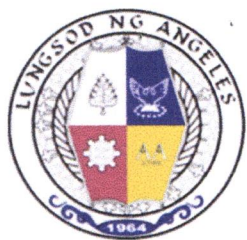
The questions shall primarily cover the **Senior High School Media and Information Literacy (MIL)** subject based on the Department of Education curriculum. Topics may include, but are not limited to:

- Introduction to Media and Information Literacy
- Types and Forms of Media
- Information Literacy and Information Sources
- Digital Literacy and Responsible Use of Technology
- Media and Information Languages
- Ethical Use of Information and Intellectual Property
- Fake News, Misinformation, Disinformation, and Fact-Checking
- Digital Citizenship and Online Safety
- Social Media Responsibility and Netiquette
- Critical Thinking and Media Analysis
- Current Issues and Trends in Media and Communication
- Media's Role in Society and Community Development

Questions may be presented in objective, situational, or application-based formats to assess participants' knowledge, analytical thinking, and ability to evaluate information in real-life situations.

Scoring System

7. The scoring system shall be as follows:
 - **Easy Round** – **1 point** for every correct answer
 - **Average Round** – **3 points** for every correct answer
 - **Difficult Round** – **5 points** for every correct answer



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8. The Quizmaster shall read each question **twice** before the allotted answering time begins.
9. Teams shall write their answers on the provided whiteboard and raise it only upon the Quizmaster's instruction. Answers revealed before the official signal may be declared invalid.
10. Questions or clarifications regarding the answer may be raised immediately after the correct answer has been announced. The decision of the **Board of Arbiters** shall be final and binding. No protest shall be entertained once the succeeding question has begun.
11. In the event of a tie affecting the final rankings, **clincher questions** shall be administered until the tie is broken.
12. Any participant found cheating, receiving unauthorized assistance, using prohibited reference materials or electronic devices, or committing any act that compromises the integrity of the competition shall be **automatically disqualified**.
13. Participants are expected to observe proper conduct, discipline, and sportsmanship throughout the competition. Any violation of the competition rules or any act of misconduct may result in disqualification upon the recommendation of the Board of Arbiters.
14. A **fifteen (15)-minute grace period** shall be observed from the official start of the competition. Teams arriving beyond the grace period shall no longer be allowed to participate and shall be considered automatically disqualified.
15. The teams with the highest accumulated scores shall be declared as:
 - **Champion**
 - **1st Runner-up**
 - **2nd Runner-up**
16. All matters not covered by these mechanics shall be resolved by the **Organizing Committee**. The decision of the Organizing Committee and the Board of Arbiters shall be **final, irrevocable, and binding**.



Youth Innovation and Invention Exhibit Guidelines

The **Youth Innovation and Invention Exhibit** is one of the official activities of the **Linggo ng Kabataan 2026** Celebration of the **City Government of Angeles**, through the **Angeles City Youth Development Office (ACYDO)**, in partnership with the **Schools Division Office of Angeles City (SDO Angeles)** and the **Angeles City Tourism Office (ACTO)**.

The exhibit will be held during the **PAMANGLAKAD Celebration** on **August 29, 2026 (1:00 PM onwards)** at the **Heritage District, Angeles City**, providing students with an opportunity to showcase their innovative ideas, inventions, and research-based projects to the public.

Objectives

The exhibit aims to:

1. Encourage creativity, innovation, and scientific thinking among students.
2. Promote practical solutions to community challenges.
3. Provide a venue for students to showcase their inventions and innovations.
4. Recognize outstanding student projects.
5. Strengthen collaboration among schools, government, and community partners.

Eligibility

1. The competition is open to all **public Junior High School (Grades 7–10) and Senior High School (Grades 11–12)** students in Angeles City.
2. Participants may compete individually or in teams of **up to five (5) members**.
3. Each participating school may submit **two (2) to three (3) innovation or invention entries**.
4. Entries may be composed of Junior High School students, Senior High School students, or a combination of both.
5. All entries must be officially endorsed by the School Principal.

Registration

1. Participating schools shall submit the **accomplished Official Entry Form (attached)** on or before **August 10, 2026**, through the official email address of the **Angeles City Youth Development Office (ACYDO)** at acydo.official@gmail.com.
2. The Entry Form must be duly certified by the School Principal or the designated School Representative.
3. Incomplete or late submissions may not be accepted by the Organizing Committee.

Nature of Entries

1. Entries may include, but are not limited to:
 - Scientific inventions
 - Engineering or technology projects
 - Robotics
 - Environmental innovations
 - Agricultural innovations
 - Health innovations
 - Educational technology
 - ICT solutions
 - Disaster preparedness innovations
 - Community-based innovations
2. Entries may be presented as:
 - Functional prototypes
 - Working models
 - Innovative products
 - Digital applications
3. All entries must be the original work of the participants.

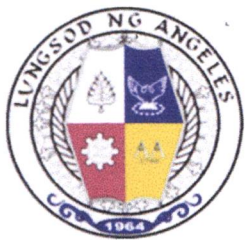


Exhibit Guidelines

1. Each approved entry shall be assigned a display booth during the exhibit.
2. Participants shall be responsible for transporting, setting up, operating, and dismantling their exhibits.
3. Each exhibit must include:
 - Project Title
 - School Name
 - Participant(s)
 - Adviser
 - Brief Project Description
 - Objectives
 - Materials Used
 - Community Benefit
4. Projects must be safe for public display. Hazardous materials, open flames, and unsafe equipment are strictly prohibited.
5. At least one (1) participant from each entry must be present during the exhibit to explain and demonstrate the project to the judges and visitors.

Presentation and Judging

1. Each entry shall be given:
 - **Five (5) minutes** for presentation and demonstration.
 - **Three (3) minutes** for the Question-and-Answer portion.
2. The order of presentations shall be determined by the Organizing Committee.
3. The decision of the Board of Judges shall be final and binding.

2. The Organizing Committee reserves the right to verify the originality of all entries and disqualify projects found to violate these guidelines.
3. All matters not covered by these guidelines shall be resolved by the Organizing Committee. Its decision shall be final and binding.

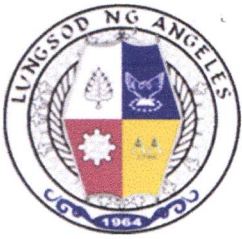
