Expenses relative to the conduct of the activity, including meals and other necessary operational expenses, shall be charged against the School-Based Feeding Program (SBFP) Division Program Support Fund (PSF), subject to the usual government accounting, auditing, budgeting, and procurement rules and regulations.
7. The SGOD-School Health and Nutrition Unit shall serve as the lead implementing office and shall be responsible for the overall coordination, preparation of conference materials, documentation, and facilitation of the activity.
8. School Heads shall ensure the attendance of their designated School-Based Feeding Program Coordinators.
