It aims to strengthen instructional leadership, enhance the exchange of effective management practices, and foster collaboration and professional learning across schools and governance levels.

3. All School Principals who are reassigned to another school shall submit their clearance to the Personnel Unit on or before August 4, 2026. The official turnover of duties and responsibilities shall be conducted on **August 7, 2026** under the supervision of the concerned Public Schools District Supervisors, in coordination with the Chief Education Supervisor–Curriculum Implementation Division (CID).

4. Teachers and non-teaching personnel of the concerned schools are hereby directed to extend their full cooperation and support to the newly reassigned School Principals, to ensure a smooth and orderly transition.
