1. In support of the Department of Education's MATATAG Agenda and the Academic Recovery and Accessible Learning (ARAL) Program, this Office, through the Curriculum and Learning Management Division, officially announces the administration of the Test of Fundamental Academic Skills (TOFAS) in partnership with SPRIX Philippines Inc.
2. TOFAS is an AI-driven, highly targeted baseline assessment tool designed to accurately evaluate our learners' foundational numeracy skills. The data gathered from this assessment will serve as the primary basis for our localized mathematics interventions and learning recovery plans.
3. The official testing window for participating schools shall run from **August 10 to August 28, 2026**. Each examination shall last 40 minutes. School Heads may schedule the test on any day within this window, provided it is administered outside regular class hours to avoid disrupting the implementation of the Instructional Block.
4. To ensure a smooth and standardized testing experience, all designated Teacher-Proctors, ICT Coordinators, and School Focal Persons are strictly directed to watch the comprehensive step-by-step video tutorial provided by SPRIX before the testing dates using this link: <https://tinyurl.com/TOFAS-Tutorial>.
5. Regional and Division Education Program Supervisors in Mathematics and Public School District Supervisors shall monitor the administration of TOFAS.

This program directly supports the **MATATAG Curriculum** by ensuring that foundational literacy and numeracy are mastered in Key Stages 2 and 3. 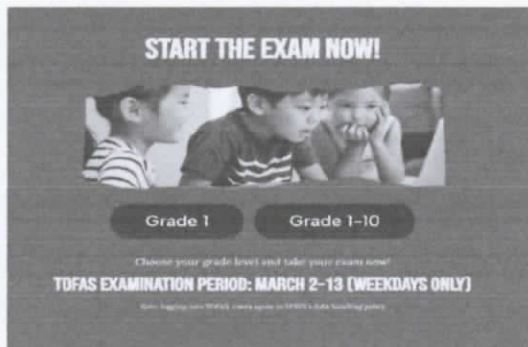

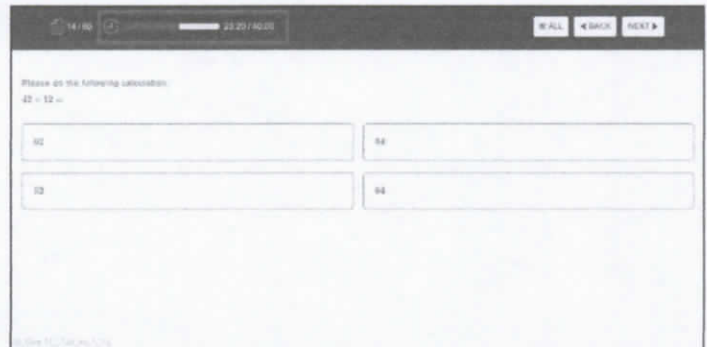
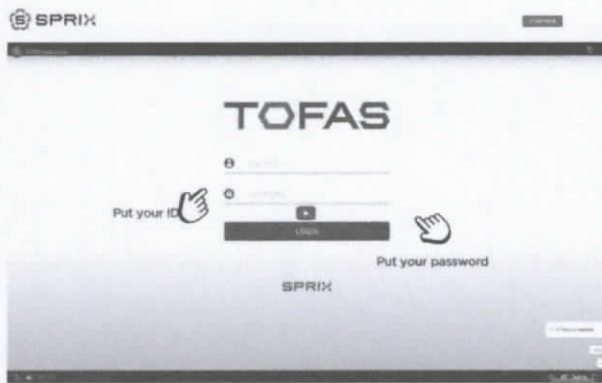

1. Ensure enough spacing between devices.
2. If using a computer lab, arrange students so that proctors at the back of the room can see all screens at once.
3. Students must remove all items from their desk except:
 - The testing device.
 - One pencil/pen.
 - One blank sheet of scratch paper
4. Since TOFAS tests calculation skills, calculators (physical or phone apps) must be strictly confiscated or placed in a "bag drop" area.
5. Designate a specific area at the front of the room where all bags and mobile phones must be deposited before the exam starts.
6. If students are using their own phones to take the test, they must disable notifications and place the phone flat on the desk. They must not access other sites.

Digital and Technical Countermeasures

1. Instruct students that opening a new browser tab or window (e.g., for Google Calculator) is prohibited.
2. Inform students that you may check their browser history immediately after the test. If "Calculator" or "Math Solver" appears in the recent history during the exam time, their score will be voided.
3. Between batches, it is recommendable to instruct students or facilitators to clear the browser cache/history to remove any trace of previous sessions.

1. To maintain the security of the test and the 40-minute timer, **restroom breaks are generally discouraged** once the exam begins but are allowed in emergencies.
2. In case of accidental internet outage, instruct the student not to close the tab or the browser window. If the questions are already loaded on the screen, the student can continue answering. The answers are saved temporarily on the device. **Provided there is an internet connection when students log in and log out, the test will be considered valid.**
3. In case of device crash/browser closure, **immediately open the browser again.**
4. Immediately instruct students to use one of the **"Buffer Accounts"** prepared for that batch if a student cannot log in.
5. If a student feels unwell, escort the student to the clinic immediately. If they completed less than **50% of the time**: The exam is considered "Void." **They may be rescheduled for a make-up session** with a different batch (using a Buffer ID).

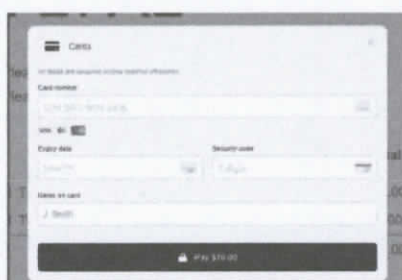

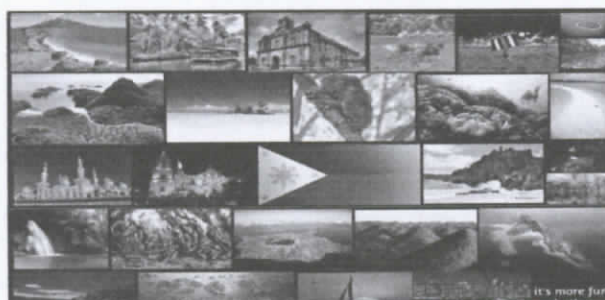

- **What are the options for schools that do not have functional computer laboratories?**
If computers are not available, students may take the assessment using tablets or smartphones. Students may use their own devices. If unavailable, the use of a parent's smartphone may be considered where feasible.
- **What is standard internet connection to take the Tofas exam?**
TOFAS does not require high internet speed. As long as you have at least 10 Mbps, you can take the exam without any issues
- **What if the internet interrupted during the examination?**
Provided there is an internet connection when students log in and log out, the test will be considered valid.

FAQ

- **Can teachers take TOFAS?**
Level 3 accounts are issued to elementary school teachers, and Level 6 accounts are issued to junior high school teachers. We encourage you to take the test.
- **What if students can't log in TOFAS?**
Please check the username and password carefully and ensure there are no typographical errors. If the student is still unable to log in, you may use the buffer account
- **Why are student names not included in the IDs and passwords provided by SPRIX?**
Student names will be entered by the students at the time of the examination. Please ensure that the same ID and password are not assigned to different students.
- **Which browsers are supported?**
TOFAS assessment supports the latest versions of Google Chrome, Mozilla Firefox, Microsoft Edge and Safari (for Mac users)
- **What if Student accidentally close the browser?**
The student can access TOFAS again and resume the test from where they left off.
- **Is email address entry mandatory?**
No. For Grades 4 and below, a dummy email address has already been assigned. For Grades 5 and above, email address entry is optional.

- **Is there a mandated schedule for the assessment, or can it be administered during regular Math periods?**

→ The assessment period is scheduled from August 10 to 28. During this period, the exam may be administered on weekdays (excluding weekends) between 6:00 AM and 8:00 PM. Schools may conduct the assessment at any suitable time within this window, including regular Math periods.

- **Does the system utilize question randomization to ensure the integrity of the assessment results?**

→ Yes. Questions are randomized while maintaining a consistent level of difficulty.

FAQ

- **What is the protocol for assisting Key Stage 1 (Grades 1–3) learners who may lack the necessary digital literacy or computer navigation skills?**

→ TOFAS does not require advanced typing skills. A large number of learners in these grade levels have already successfully taken the assessment. Since login and password entry may require assistance, teachers are encouraged to support students. Teachers are also advised to instruct students to review the tutorial instructions, enter their answers carefully, and click the Finish button upon completion.

- **What are the recommended options for schools in Geographically Isolated and Disadvantaged Areas (GIDA) with limited or intermittent internet connectivity?**

→ TOFAS Math is designed as a lightweight system and does not rely on video content. Students may take the exam as long as an internet connection is available at the time of login and submission only. Even with unstable connectivity, the assessment can generally be completed. If the school has no internet access, the use of mobile data via smartphones may be considered where feasible.

- **Are teachers and school administrators permitted to undergo a simulation or "trial run" of the exam prior to the actual student rollout?**

→ Yes. Teachers will be provided with Level 1 accounts for familiarization and simulation purposes.
