PHILIPPINE PUBLIC SCHOOL TEACHERS ASSOCIATION (PPSTA) CONDUCT OF MEMBERSHIP CAMPAIGNS IN SCHOOLS

1. This Office disseminates **Regional Memorandum No. 276, s. 2026**, dated August 4, 2026, entitled "**Philippine Public School Teachers Association (PPSTA) Conduct of Membership Campaigns in Schools**".
2. Schools are advised that the participation in membership campaigns shall remain **strictly voluntary** subject to existing Department of Education policies, rules, and regulations governing school operations, partnerships, and the conduct of activities within school premises.
3. School Principals shall ensure that any conduct of membership campaign or information dissemination within their respective schools shall:
 - be scheduled without disrupting classes, learning delivery, assessment activities, official school functions, or instructional time;
 - observe existing DepEd issuances on the utilization of school facilities and engagement with external stakeholders;
 - uphold the principles of professionalism, transparency, inclusivity, and respect for the individual decisions of teachers and personnel regarding association membership; and
 - ensure that no teacher or personnel is compelled, coerced, or unduly influenced to become a member of the association or to participate in any membership-related activity.
4. Any coordination relative to the scheduling of school visits or campaign sessions shall be made directly with the concerned School Principal to ensure proper planning.
5. Attached to this Advisory is a copy of **Regional Memorandum No. 276, s. 2026**, for reference and appropriate information of all concerned.
6. Immediate and widest dissemination of this Advisory is desired.
